



## NOTICE OF KEY DECISION

<p><b>ITEM FOR CONSIDERATION</b></p>	<p><b>LCR 62 - Access to Halsnead Garden Village</b></p> <p>Consideration of a grant funding request to the Strategic Investment Fund (round I), to support off site road junction improvements linked to the wider delivery of Halsnead Garden Village.</p> <p>Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council, as applicant, has submitted a full business case to the Combined Authority; this has been independently appraised by transport specialists Steer Davies Gleave. It is intended that the request for funding will be considered by the Combined Authority on the 11 January 2019.</p> <p>The proposed junction improvements are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fox's bank Lane/Cronton Road - signalisation and road widening</li> <li>• Lickers Lane/Fox's Bank Lane - signalisation, footway improvements and vegetation removal</li> <li>• Stoney Lane/Cumber Lane – signalisation works</li> <li>• Stoney Lane/Dragon Lane - carriageway widening and creation of right turn pocket</li> <li>• Windy Arbor Road/Greene's Road - reconfiguration of junction</li> <li>• Lickers Lane/Windy Arbor Road - carriageway widening and signalisation</li> <li>• M62 (Jn 6)/M57/A5300 interchange at Tarbock Island - carriageway and bridge widening on approach, quadrant widening to the gyratory, additional lane provision on M57 approach, signalisation of uncontrolled arms</li> </ul> <p>Completion of these works will help facilitate the development of Halsnead Garden Village (as a dependent development). As one of 14 designated Garden Villages by government in 2017, the delivery of Halsnead will create 1,600 new residential units and 22.5ha of employment land for B8 uses.</p>
